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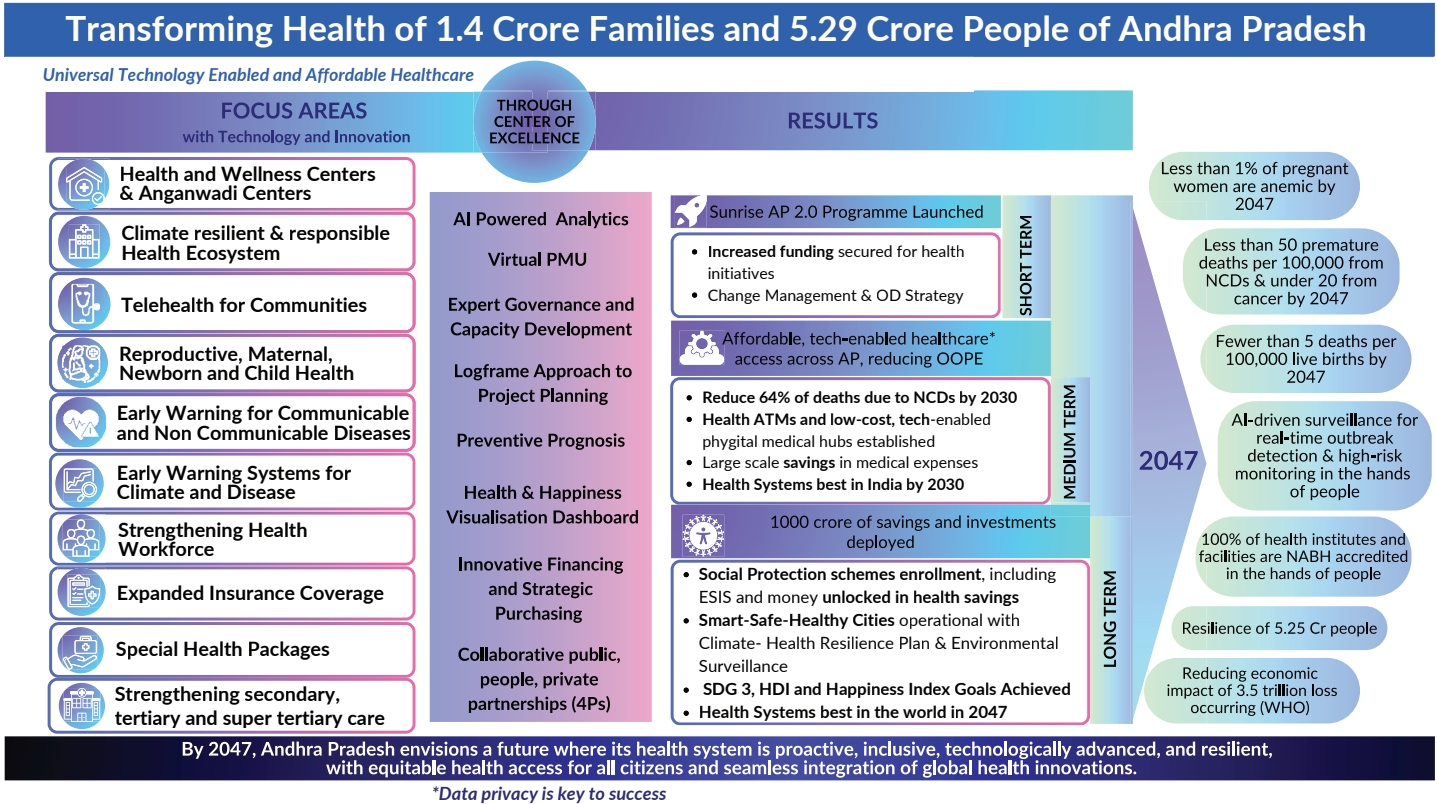

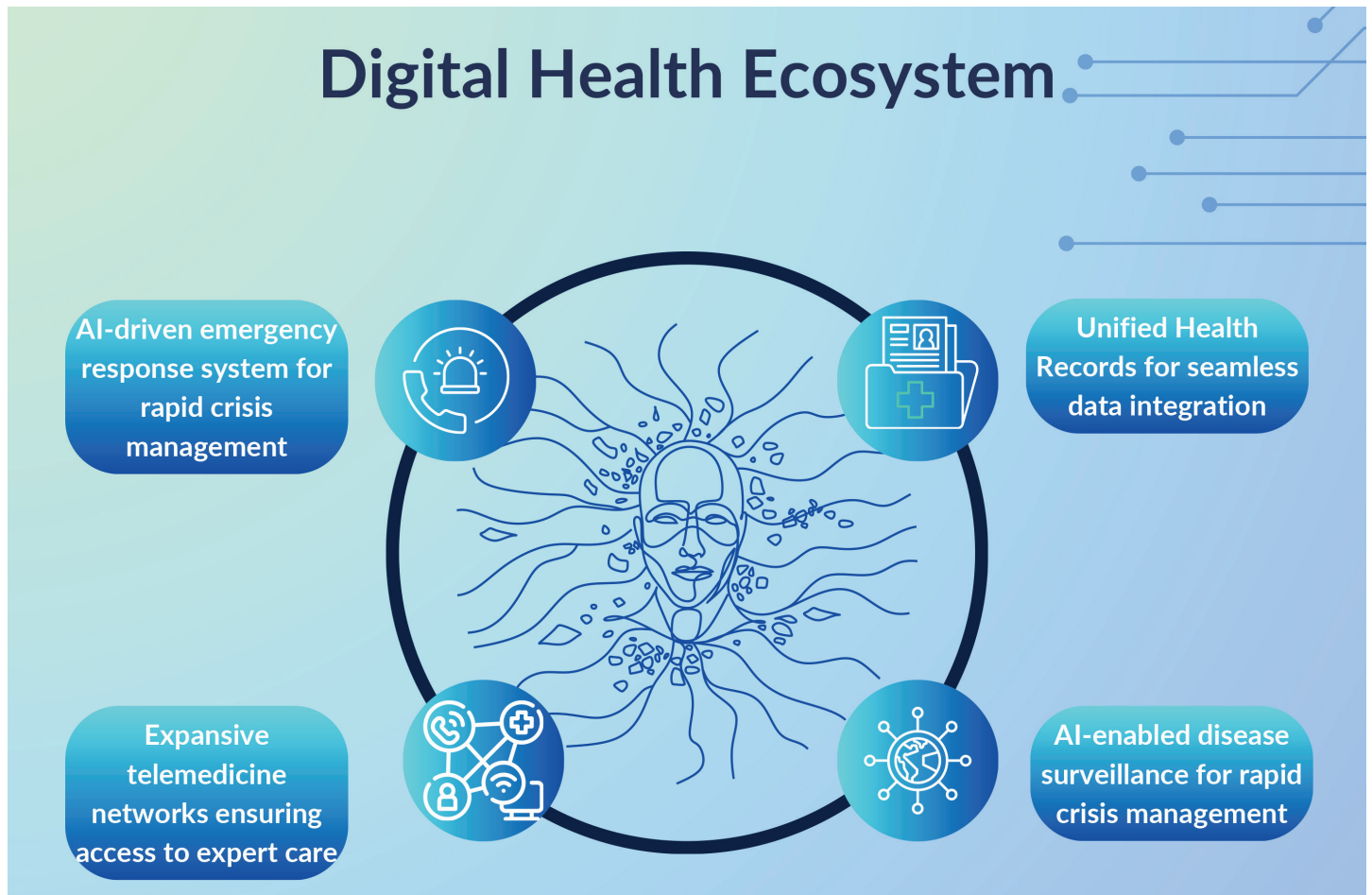
The intervention will allow Andhra Pradesh to become a pioneer in telemedicine, handling an increasingly larger share of consultations and setting standards for decentralized care delivery.

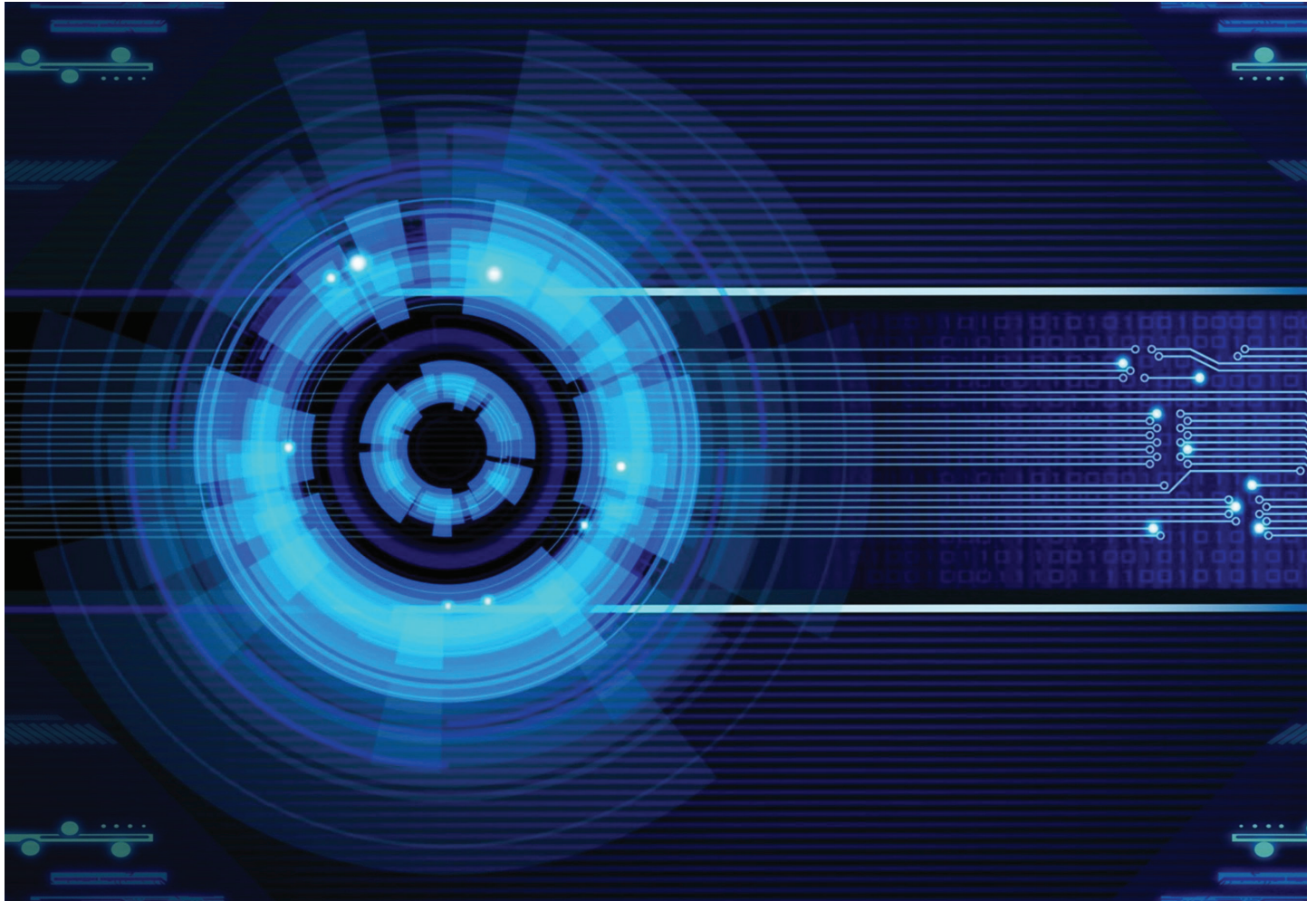

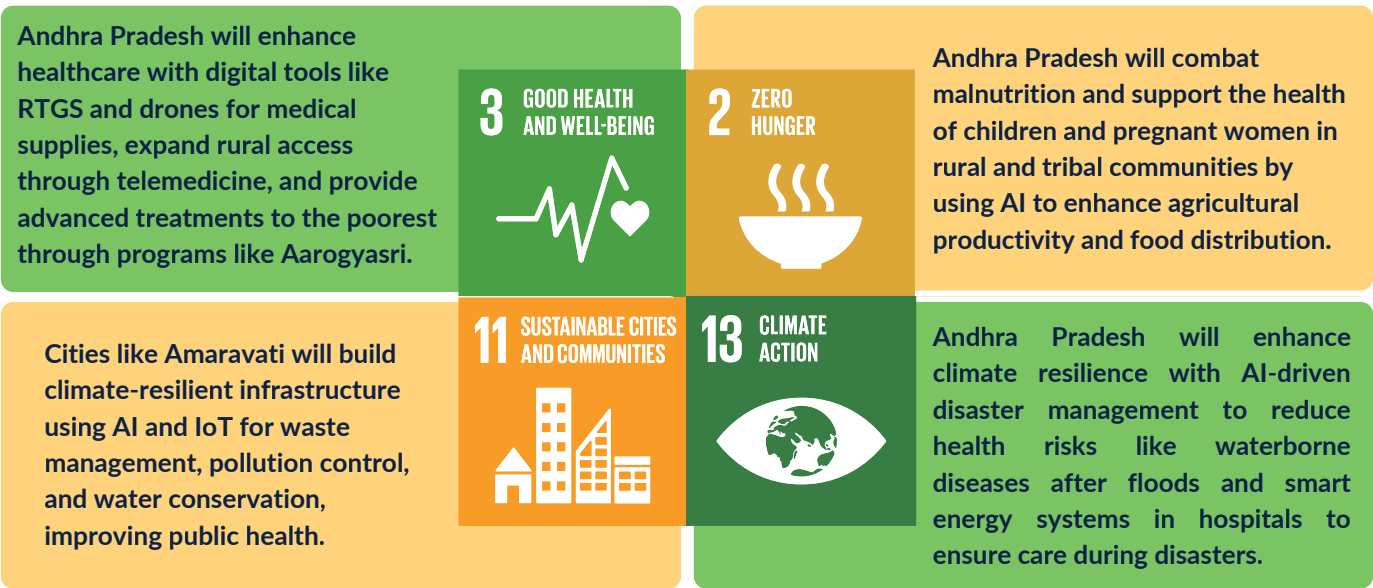

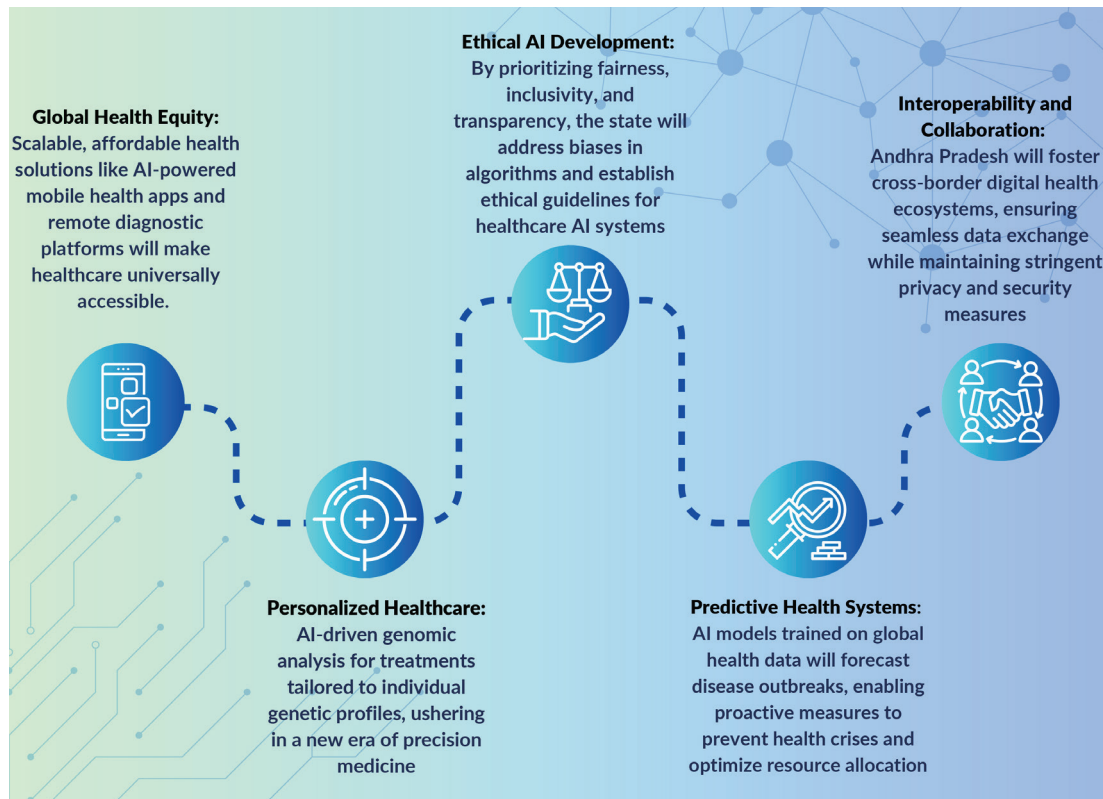
